I would like to thank you for taking a few minutes of your time and allow me the privilege of sharing with you the many benefits of joining this organization. OSCHE began in June of 1991 with seven member institutions of higher education. The mission of OSCHE is to serve as a collaborative body that fosters positive staff relations between institutions of higher education, State, and local administrations. In addition, OSCHE partners with all state-assisted institutions of higher education in Ohio in an effort to promote and gather information and to inform our constituents of ideas and concerns regarding all staff councils. Being a part of OSCHE also offers an atmosphere of support and unity between all member institutions.

What institutions are eligible for membership?

Any two or four year public, state-assisted institution of higher education having non-union employees is eligible for membership.

What are other benefits of being a member?

Institutions will be able to attend quarterly meetings on a trial basis. Your paid membership gains you the opportunity to have two voting seats and up to three alternates representing your institution. In addition, your paid membership gets you one free registration at the two-day Summer Conference.

This is a tremendous opportunity for your institution to take the next step in staff organization that has a pulse of other institutions of higher education throughout The State of Ohio.

Soon, an OSCHE representative will be contacting you to see if you have questions regarding OSCHE. The representative will also see if you would like to have an on-site visit with OSCHE and your staff council, committee, or senate.
